AMERICAN LEGION POST 1640 SCHOLARSHIP

March 30, 2023

The North Collins American Legion Post 1640 will provide five (5) scholarships each year to graduating seniors of the North Collins Central School District. They are as follows: three \$300 scholarships and two \$300 grants.

The scholarships and grants will be given to students who will be furthering their education beyond high school. The scholarship or grant money will be forwarded to the recipients upon evidence of matriculation in the post high school program by the North Collins Central School System. Letters explaining the scholarship and grant procedures will be given to the recipients at graduation.

POST SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Scholarship/Grant selection committee will consist of the following:

1. Three representatives from the American Legion Post 1640.
2. The senior guidance counselor of the North Collins Central School shall act as consultant to the Post Selection Committee.

General Requirements for Eligibility

1. Candidate must be a permanent resident of the North Collins Central School District.
2. Applicants for any of the **scholarships** must be in the upper half of his/her class, scholastically.
3. Applicants for the **grants** do not have to be in the upper half of her/her class, scholastically.
4. Candidates must apply for the scholarships or grants in writing on the appropriate form which may be obtained from the guidance center at the North Collins Central School.
5. Candidates must return completed application to the guidance center at the North Collins Central School by **April 14, 2023**.

Funding

1. Any and all scholarships and grants will be received only upon verification to the North Collins Central School authorities of their enrollment and attendance at the institution of their choice.
2. All funds have been provided and shall be disbursed by the American Legion Post 1640, North Collins.

Special Requirements for Eligibility

Three \$300 Scholarships

Candidate must have applied and is planning to enroll in a four, three or two year program of study at an accredited institution beyond high school. This may include a two-year college, technical institute, business school or nursing school.

One \$300 Grant

A \$300 grant will be awarded to a graduating senior who has applied to an accredited post-high school program of study. The applicant does not have to be in the upper ½ of his/her class.

One \$300 Grant

A \$300 grant will be awarded to a graduating senior who has applied and plans to further his/her education beyond high school in a trade, eg. beautician, welder, etc. Applicant does not have to be in the upper ½ of his/her class.
